Duration, Attendance and Delivery

A blended learning approach will combine online learning, group workshops, learning sets, personal coaching session and support for work based projects and assessment tasks that will lead to a Post Graduate Certificate in Professional Practice (Evidence Based Commissioning).

Deadline for submission of application is 24th October and Interviews are taking place on the 7th November 2016 at the Innovation Agency, SciTech Park, Warrington.

- Ability to commit to a year-long applied work-based learning programme
- Committed to the NHS Innovation and Improvement Agenda
- Commitment to own personal and professional development
- Support from own organisation to apply learning into workplace practice
- *academic fees will be provided and sessional backfill for GPs and GP trainees is available
